#### Yarn

MC: 1 (1, 1, 2, 2) skeins <u>Cascade 220 Superwash (100% Superwash Wool – 220 yds per 100g skein)</u> Color #864 Christmas Green CC1: 1 Skein <u>Cascade 220 Superwash</u> – Color #871 White CC2: 1 Skein <u>Cascade 220 Superwash</u> – Color #815 Black

#### Needles & Notions

Size G (4.0mm) Hook Yarn Needle 5 gold buttons (3/8"-1/2") Needle & Thread

#### Gauge

18sts x 16 rows = 4" in half double crochet

## Sizes & Finished Measurements

3 (6, 12, 18, 24) months Chest measures 18 (19, 21, 22, 23) inches. Finished Length 9 (10, 11, 12, 13) inches.

## Things to Note

The body for this sweater is worked in one piece, and the sleeves are worked in the round to the sleeve cap to reduce the amount of seaming that needs to be done. # Body

Using MC, ch 83 (87, 97, 101, 105) sts.

Row 1: hdc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, hdc in each ch to end. (81, 85, 95, 99, 103 body sts) Row 2: ch2, hdc to end

Work even in hdc for 8 (8, 9, 9 9) more rows. Work 5 rows with CC2. Continue working even in hdc with MC until body measures approximately 4.75 (5.5, 6.25, 7, 7.75) inches from beg.

#### Left Front

Row 1: ch2, hdc 18 (19, 21, 22, 23) Row 2: ch2, hdc1, hdc2tog, hdc to end Row 3: ch2, hdc to last 3 sts of prev row, hdc2tog, hdc1 Work even across 16 (17, 19, 20, 21) sts for 9 (11, 11, 13, 13) rows.

Next Row: sl 4 sts, sc1, hdc to end Next Row: ch2, hdc 11 (12, 13, 14, 15), sc1

Next Row: ch2, hdc 11 (12, 13, 14, 15), sc1 Next Row: sl 2 sts, sc1, hdc to end Next Row: ch2, hdc 7 (8, 9, 10, 11)

Repeat last row 1 (0, 1, 0, 1) times; break yarn & fasten off.

#### Back

Reattach yarn 4 sts away from left front

Row 1: ch2, hdc 37 (39, 45, 47, 49) Row 2: ch2, hdc1, hdc2tog, hdc to last 3 sts of prev row, hdc2tog, hdc1

Repeat last row once more. Work even across 33 (35, 41, 43, 45) sts for 11 (12, 13, 14, 15) rows.

Next Row: ch2, hdc 11 (12, 13, 14, 15), sc1 Next Row: sl 3 sts, sc1, hdc to end Next Row: ch2, hdc 7 (8, 9, 10, 11) sts.

Break yarn & fasten off. Reattach yarn at opposite edge and repeat the last 3 rows for the other shoulder.

## **Right Front**

Reattach yarn 4 sts away from back

Row 1: ch2, hdc 18 (19, 21, 22, 23) to end Row 2: ch2, hdc to last 3 sts of prev row, hdc2tog, hdc1 Row 3: ch2, hdc1, hdc2tog, hdc to end

Work even across 16 (17, 19, 20, 21) sts for 10 (10, 12, 12, 14) rows.

Next Row: sl 4 sts, sc1, hdc to end Next Row: ch2, hdc 11 (12, 13, 14, 15), sc1 Next Row: sl 2 sts, sc1, hdc to end Next Row: ch2, hdc 7 (8, 9, 10, 11)

Repeat last row 0 (1, 0, 1, 0) time; break yarn & fasten off.

## Button Band

Using MC, attach yarn at front corner with RS facing. Work 32 (36, 40, 44, 48) hdc evenly spaced across front edge.

**Row 2:** ch1, sc 1, \*ch1, sk next st, sc 6 (7, 8, 9, 10); rep from \* 4 times, ch 1, sk next st, sc to end **Row 3:** ch2, hdc in each st & ch 1 sp to end

Break yarn & fasten off. Reattach yarn on opposite front edge with RS facing. Work 32 (36, 40, 44, 48) hdc evenly spaced across front edge, then work 1 row of sc and 1 row of hdc. Break yarn & fasten off.

# Sleeves — Make 2

Using CC1, ch 21 (23, 25, 27, 30) sts. SI st in beg ch to create a loop.

Rnd 1: hdc in each ch around, sl st in first st, *turn work* Rnd 2: ch2, sk first st, hdc in each st to end, sl st in first st, *turn* 

Switch to MC. Continue switching between MC and CC1 every 2 rnds for remainder of sleeve. Repeat **Rnd 2** 6 (6, 8, 8, 9) times more.

**Next (Inc) Rnd:** ch2, sk first st, 2hdc in next st, hdc to last 2 sts, 2hdc in next st, hdc1, sl st in first st, *turn* 

Repeat **Rnd 2** 7 (7, 9, 9, 10) times, then repeat **Inc Rnd** once. (25, 27, 29, 31, 34 sts after last inc row) Continue working even until sleeve measures 6 (6.5, 7.5, 8, 8.5) inches from beg. Start working sleeve cap flat (do not sl st at the end of each rnd)

Next Row: sl 2, hdc to last 2 sts, turn

Work the following Dec Row every other row 6 (6, 7, 7, 8) times

**Dec Row:** ch2, hdc1, hdc2tog, hdc to last 3 sts of prev row, hdc2tog, hdc1

9 (11, 11, 13, 14) sts rem. Break yarn & fasten off.

## Collar

Using CC1, ch 44 (44, 50, 50, 50).

**Row 1:** hdc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, hdc in each ch to end (42, 42, 48, 48, 48 sts)

Row 2: ch2, [hdc 5, 2hdc in next st] to end

Row 3: ch2, [hdc 6, 2hdc in next st] to end

Row 4: ch2, [hdc 7, 2hdc in next st] to end

Row 5: ch2, [hdc 8, 2hdc in next st] to end

Row 6: ch2, [hdc 9, 2hdc in next st] to end

Row 7: ch2, [hdc 10, 2hdc in next st] to end

Row 8: ch2, [hdc 11, 2hdc in next st] to end

Break yarn & fasten off.

## Finishing

Block pieces to schematic measurements. SI st 7 (8, 9, 10, 11) front & back shoulder sts together on each side. Sew sleeve into armhole, easing as necessary. Attach collar to neckline edge by placing collar flat along neckline (be sure that button hole on collar lines up with button holes on front edge) and working a row of sc through both the collar and neckline stitches, working 36 (36, 40, 40, 40) sc evenly spaced along collar.

Sew buttons to button band to match button holes. Weave in all ends.
